On the 1st of May 2023, the New Plymouth City Council meeting was called to order at 6:00 P.M. by Mayor Rick York.

Roll call was taken with council members Heather Airoidi, Cora Kurth, Eileen Balcer, Bill Warnke, and Mayor York present.

April 17, 2023, City Council Minutes- Action Item

Councilwoman Balcer made a motion to approve the minutes from April 17, 2023. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Claim Approvals- Action Item

Councilwoman Airoidi made a motion to approve the claim approvals totalling \$19,440.04. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. Motion carried.

New Business-

a. SERDA- Kristen Nieskens- moved to the 1st meeting in June due to illness.

b. Sunny's Car Rally- Don Littlefield (Action Item)

Don Littlefield addressed the council about this year's car rally to be held on 10/07/2023 in Kiwanis Park. He thanked the council for their support, and the mayor and city clerk for their participation.

Councilman Warnke made a motion to approve the special events permit for Sunny's Car Rally on 10/07/2023 in Kiwanis Park. Councilwoman Balcer seconded the motion. Motion carried.

c. Public Works Surplus Items (Action Item) Public Works superintendent Beau Ziemer said there are a few items that public works is needing to get rid of. He plans to take the dump truck and pick up to auction and the roller to the scrap yard.

Councilwoman Balcer made a motion to approve the public works surplus of the dump truck, pick up and roller. Councilwoman Kurth seconded the motion. Motion carried.
